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General Information

Crawford Area Scholarships, Inc., a Pennsylvania non-profit corporation of Meadville, Pennsylvania is pleased to offer scholarship awards to one or more qualifying high school senior students. The number of awards available and the amount of each award will be announced at the beginning of each application period.

It is our hope that the award(s) will help the recipient(s) pursue their academic goals, complete their formal education, and contribute to their efforts to become productive participants in their communities.

2019 Availability

There will be **two (2) one thousand dollar (\$1,000.00)** scholarship awards available to Crawford County students graduating in the year 2019.

Eligibility

Any high school senior meeting the following criteria may apply:

- Minimum High School Grade Point Average (GPA) of 3.20
GPA requirement is based on a 4.0 scale, counselors are asked to convert students' GPA if calculated on a different scale.
- Acceptance at or intent to attend an accredited technical school or undergraduate college.
- Student must be a graduating senior from a high school located within Crawford County, PA.

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Procedures

APPLICATION: Applications for this scholarship will consist of four (4) parts:

1) Completed application forms.

Forms to apply for this scholarship may be obtained by writing to Crawford Area Scholarships, Inc., PO Box 323, Meadville, PA 16335. Forms will also be available from the High School Guidance Counselor at each of the Crawford County Schools. **Applications will be available in January and must be received at the post office no later than April 15th. Late or incomplete applications will NOT be considered.**

2) An essay of 500 – 1000 words must accompany the completed application forms. The topic for the essay will be announced each year at the beginning of the application period. **Essays must be on the assigned topic.**

3) Personal references.

4) Personal statement ***NOTE: Please identify the essay and personal statement.***

APPLICATION PERIOD: To be considered for an award, completed forms, reference letters and personal statement must be **POSTMARKED no earlier than March 1st and RECEIVED no later than April 15th.** All appropriate portions of the forms must be **completed by the applicant and his or her principal or guidance counselor** and accompanied by the required essay and reference letters.

Incomplete applications will not be considered.
Time deadlines will be strictly enforced. Do not depend on your Counselor, Principal, Parent or Teachers to send in your scholarship application. It is **YOUR** responsibility to get it to us **BEFORE** April 15, 2019. Off-topic essays may disqualify the application.

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SELECTION and NOTIFICATION: The Scholarship Selection Committee will review all qualified applications. Scholarship winners will be notified by mail.

SELECTION CRITERIA: Applicants will be reviewed with consideration given to:

- Community and other activities
- Honors and awards received
- Extracurricular activities
- Essay content and structure (**off topic essays may disqualify the application**)
- Personal Statement content
- Personal references
- Academic Record
- Incomplete applications will not be considered
- **Do not depend on your Counselor, Principal, Parent or Teachers to send in your scholarship application. It is YOUR responsibility to get it to us BEFORE April 15, 2019.**

Financial need will not be considered

PAYMENT: The recipient will be notified by mail. It is the responsibility of the recipient to notify the Scholarship Committee of the College they will be attending. **Awards will be made payable jointly to the recipient and the institution they are attending. The check will be sent to the financial office of that institution.**

EQUAL OPPORTUNITY: The Scholarship Committee will not discriminate on the basis of race, color, sex, national origin, religion, or handicap when selecting recipients.
